Instructions for use and maintenance of products made of stainless steel

1. Bicycle racks or other Venag products should be mounted by concreting the underground part of the rack in a concrete foundation (concrete class at least C8 / 10).
2. Cement and mortar stains formed during assembly should be removed. They can be removed with a cleaning preparation containing a small dose of phosphoric acid.
3. Iron particles left on the surface of the stand, formed during the assembly, should be removed immediately.
4. Stainless steel elements should be regularly maintained by covering the metal surfaces of the stand with a preparation for the care of stainless steel. It is recommended to carry out at least two maintenance per year (before the winter season and after the winter season).
5. Dirt or rubbish such as leaves, stones, papers, tree needles, etc. appearing in the surrounding area should be systematically removed.
6. The user / administrator of the facility is obliged to maintain the elements of small architecture on an ongoing basis.
